I first got involved in 'Saol na Gaeilge' in 2019 when I was in first year. I decided to join An Chuallacht to immerse myself in student activities. Since then, I was on the committee for An Chuallacht, An Cumann Dramaíochta and I lived in UCC's Irish speaking accommodation Ársa Uí Thuama.

Aims:

- To advance the Irish Language throughout UCC Satellite Campuses.
- To encourage students to interact with the language.
- To organize events and celebrate Irish culture on campus.
- To further develop the Irish-language magazine, Breac.
- To maintain and expand policies put in place by previous Officers.

An Ghaeilge ar Champas :

Ar ndóigh, an chéad phointe atá agam is an ról is tabhactaí atá ag an Oifigeach, ná gur mhaith liom an Ghaeilge a chur chun cinn ar an gcampas. Ba cheart go mbeadh an Ghaeilge feiceálach i ngach áit ar an gcampas, ní hamháin i gcúpla ait. Táim ag iarraidh béim a chur ar na fó-champais ach go háirthe. Feicim nach mbíonn an mhéid chéanna Gaeilge le cloisteáil iontu is mar is féidir. Tá neart daltaí nach mbíonn ag freastal ar léachtaí ar an bpriomh champas, mise san áireamh, is bíonn sé níos deacra páirt a ghlacadh i saol na Gaeilge mar sin. Gaeilge on Campus:

My primary aim as the Irish Officer would be to spread the Irish language across campus and to encourage people to speak to each other using the language. I believe that Irish events should be made accessible to all regardless of where on campus they may be studying. There are not enough Irish events occurring on satellite campuses and I would like to rectify this. It is in these smaller campuses that I see myself making the biggest changes.

I want to make Irish events accessible to all. This will be achieved by organizing regular bilingual events on and off campus. It is important that the Union supports those learning the language as well as those who want to learn more or simply find a place to practice their Irish.

Cursai Leanúna:

Project Expansion

Cafe na Gaeilge: In my opinion the cafe is one of the most important developments that must come to fruition as soon as possible. There should be a designated social hub on campus where Irish is the primary language used to communicate. Although there is no quick solution to this goal, I will put every effort in on my part to continue that great work that has been previously put into the effort.

Meitheal na Gaeilge: Meitheal is an old Irish descriptive term that encompasses people coming together to work and support each other. This was an initiative adopted by Darragh Ó Caoimh to get students involved in a range of tasks to help support Irish in UCC. This allows students to gain experience and develop valuable skills. I will be looking to continue this initiative due to the success of it in the past year.
