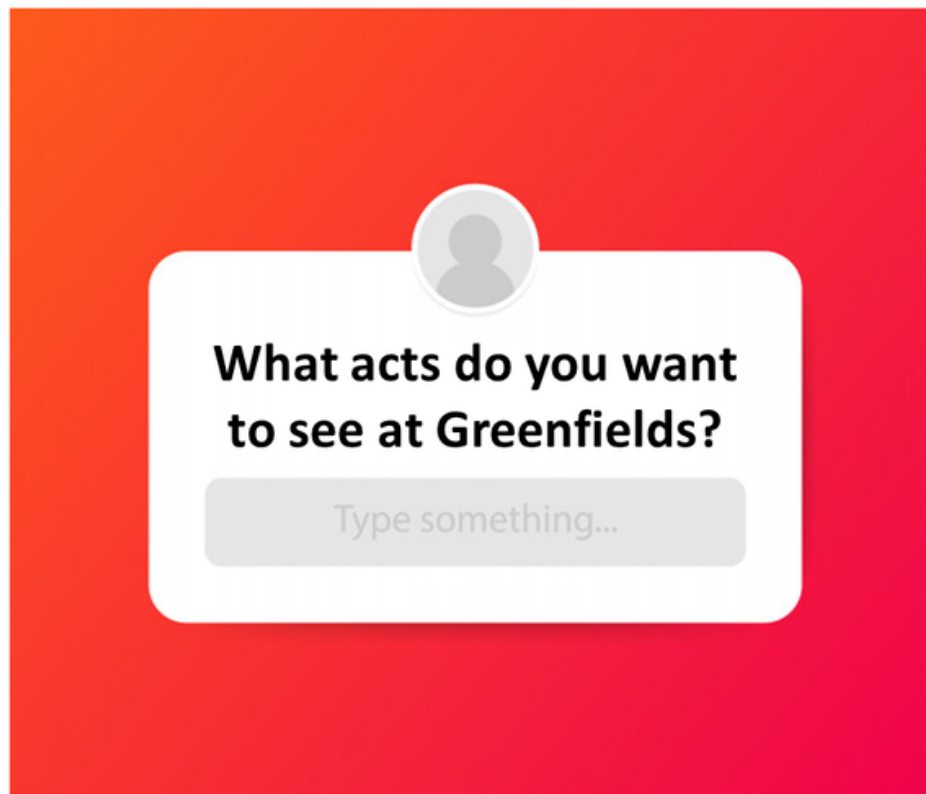

Leading up to summer, I want to get a large screen and a projector in the amphitheatre, and host a weekly outdoor movie (weather permitting).

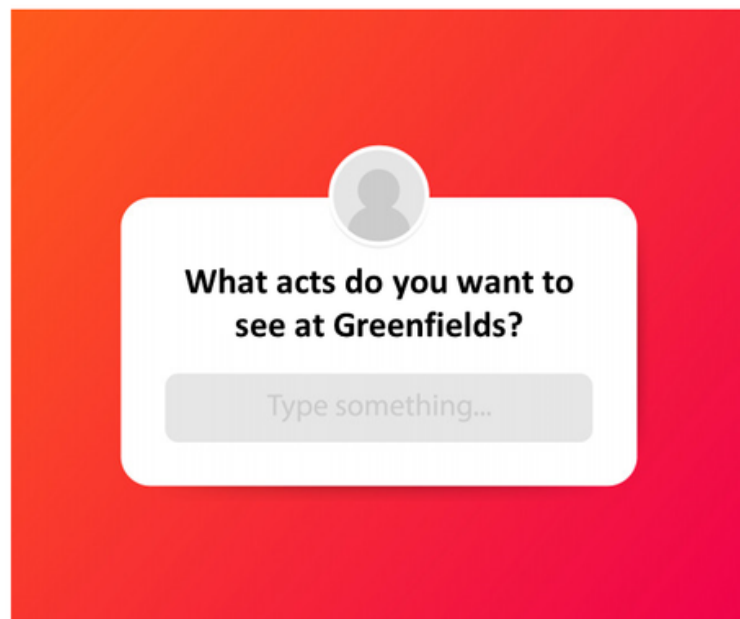
I also want to use the screen for big sporting events; last week the sun was splitting the stones for Cheltenham and the amphitheatre would've been a perfect place to watch it.
